


APPENDIX B - SITE PLAN



**Location Notes:**

The work(s) must be located within site boundary (See plan to left) in accordance with the following requirements:

- The work(s) shall be located in the grassy area shown.
- All proposed work(s) must be 450mm from any curbs or asphalt edges.
- Proposed public art structures should not exceed 6 m (20 ft.) in height.
- Work shall not impede pedestrian movement along the Waterfront Trail.
- All work shall be designed and located in such a way as to provide a minimum clearance of 3.0 metres between itself and all existing trees on site.
- Any work proposed shall not have any ledges, surfaces or other features that will allow for climbing.
- No work may be attached to utility poles
- Work cannot cover existing utilities
- Must not be allowed to move or turn by mechanical or other means.
- Must not have flashing lights or intermittent or activated lighting of any kind, including searchlights used solely as a means of attracting attention.
- The work must be designed in a way that it can be removed and reinstalled by City staff or contractors if site conditions change in the future.






