## **BY-LAW NO. 08-102**

## A BY-LAW TO SET OPTIONAL PROPERTY CLASSES FOR THE YEAR 2008

**WHEREAS** the property classes have been prescribed by the Minister of Finance under the <u>Assessment Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c. A.31;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton, pursuant to the <u>Assessment Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c. A.31, has the right to adopt optional property classes for the 2008 taxation year;

**AND WHEREAS** it is necessary for the Council of the City of Hamilton, pursuant to the <u>Assessment Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c. A.31, to pass a by-law to establish optional property classes for the 2008 taxation year.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

- 1. For the 2008 taxation year, the following optional classes as defined in Ontario Regulation 282/98 shall apply in the City of Hamilton:
  - (a) parking lots and vacant land property class;
  - (b) large industrial property class;
  - (c) new multi-residential property class.
- 2. This By-law shall be deemed to have come into force as of January 1st, 2008.
