BY-LAW NO. 10-265

Respecting:

Removal of Part Lot Control Block 69, Registered Plan No. 62M-1142 Binbrook Heights

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control.** -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, for the purpose of creating 28 individual street townhouse lots/units shown as Parts 1-56, inclusive, including utility/servicing easements shown as Parts 29-56, inclusive, and for the purpose of creating one (1) part, for a common element condominium consisting of, but not limited to, a common element roadway, visitor's parking area, landscaped area and a utility/servicing easement, shown as Part 57, on the deposited Reference Plan 62R-18861, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Block 69, Registered Plan No. 62M-1142, formerly the Township of Glanbrook, now in the City of Hamilton

- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- 3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 13th day of October, 2012.
