BY-LAW NO. 12-239

Removal of Part Lot Control Lots 1 to 41, inclusive, Registered Plan No. 62M-1176 "Oasis – Phase 1B", 170 Palacebeach Trail (Stoney Creek) (Ward 11)

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating construction, maintenance, repair, and utility easements in favour of the utility companies and the future condominium corporation on Block 42, 62M-1176, shown as Parts 1 to 72, inclusive, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-19405, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Lots 1 to 41, inclusive, Registered Plan No. 62M-1176, in the City of Stoney Creek

- This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force 2. and effect on the date of such registration.
- 3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 24th day of October, 2014.
