**Application for Medical Special Consideration for Garbage Container Limits**

The City of Hamilton has a special consideration provision to allow an increase to the garbage container limit for residents with medical circumstances demonstrating a need for additional waste containers. By completing and submitting this application, upon approval eligible properties will be provided with trash tags to be used at their discretion to set out additional containers of garbage weekly on their waste collection day. For continued uninterrupted service, residents must reapply yearly for Special Consideration by March 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Unlimited quantities of recycling may be set out every week for collection.**
