BY-LAW NO. 14-332

TO RESCIND BY-LAW 14-196 AND TO INCORPORATE CITY LAND DESIGNATED AS PART 15 ON PLAN 62R-19306 INTO RALFANA CRESCENT

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is empowered under <u>Section 31(1) of</u> <u>The Municipal Act, 2001, Chapter 25</u> and amendments thereto, to establish and lay out, widen, alter, divert, stop-up, lease or sell any highway or part of a highway.

AND WHEREAS through inadvertence the Council of the City of Hamilton passed By-Law 14-196 which referred incorrectly to Block 15 on Plan 62R-19306.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton deems it necessary to incorporate the land described below into the highway known as Ralfana Crescent within its limits;

AND WHEREAS the said land is owned by the City of Hamilton.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That the following land is hereby established and laid out as a public highway to form part of Ralfana Crescent.

Part of Block 23, on Plan 62M-1140 in the City of Hamilton. Designated as Part 15 on Plan 62R-19306.

By-Law 14-196 is Repealed.

- 2. That the General Manager of Public Works or his duly authorized agent is hereby authorized to open the said land as a public highway.
- 3. That this by-law comes into force and takes effect on the date of its registration in the Land Registry Office (No. 62).
