In 2018, the Planning Committee approved Report PED18082, Financial Incentives for Taxi Operators to Provide Accessible Taxicab Trips. This established a Pilot Program that provides a \$5 flat subsidized rate to all qualified accessible taxicab drivers for each accessible taxi trip dispatched by Hamilton Cab and Blue Line Taxi Brokers.

The Pilot Program was paused in early 2020 at the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. It will resume in August 2021 with applicable payments being paid to taxicab drivers in September 2021. The Pilot Program will continue to be funded through the Personal Transportation Provider (PTP) Licensing Fee which allows for \$0.05 per trip originating in the City of Hamilton to go directly towards the Program, allowing for on-demand accessible transportation. The Program continues to enhance mobility and reduces social isolation for those with disabilities in Hamilton communities. Licensing and By-Law Services is committed to providing a safe, sustainable and customer focused transportation network.
