On January 31, 2020, the Ministry of Transportation wrote to staff requesting three presentations from City staff to the Task Force on the following topics:

- 1. Transportation Master Plan (TMP)
- 2. Ten-Year Local Transit Strategy
- 3. Corporate Goals and Council Priorities

Consistent with our previous Information Update, staff reiterated that it is our preference that any staff presentations to the Task Force be open to the public. The Ministry of Transportation has indicated that this is not an option, and that any presentations would have to be done in-camera.

On that basis, staff has responded as follows.

With respect to the Transportation Master Plan, staff directed the Task Force to the web link of the General Issues Committee (GIC) meeting of June 20, 2018 where Director Brian Hollingworth presented the TMP to Council (please see link below).
