Mr. Mayor and Members of Council, the following highlights emergency works related to the repairs at Bridge 452-Centennial Parkway (near Ridge Road).

A structural evaluation was carried out in September 2019 by Dillon Consulting (Dillon). At that time Dillon identified some elements within the structure that required immediate attention.

The City retained Dillon under a Policy 10 as of September 24<sup>th</sup> to design and execute immediate repairs. Dillon monitored the structure regularly while completing the design and acquiring the needed permits.

As communicated via e-mail on October 24th, the city closed the lanes and notified Council and the public of the required urgent repairs. In the interest of public safety, the City retained Clearwater Structures to implement traffic control accommodations and restrict vehicular traffic on the affected areas of the bridge deck. The City retained Dillon to plan the rehabilitation strategy and act as a contract administrator during construction. Repairs were completed on December 11th, 2019. A breakdown of costs by contractor / consultant follows:
