

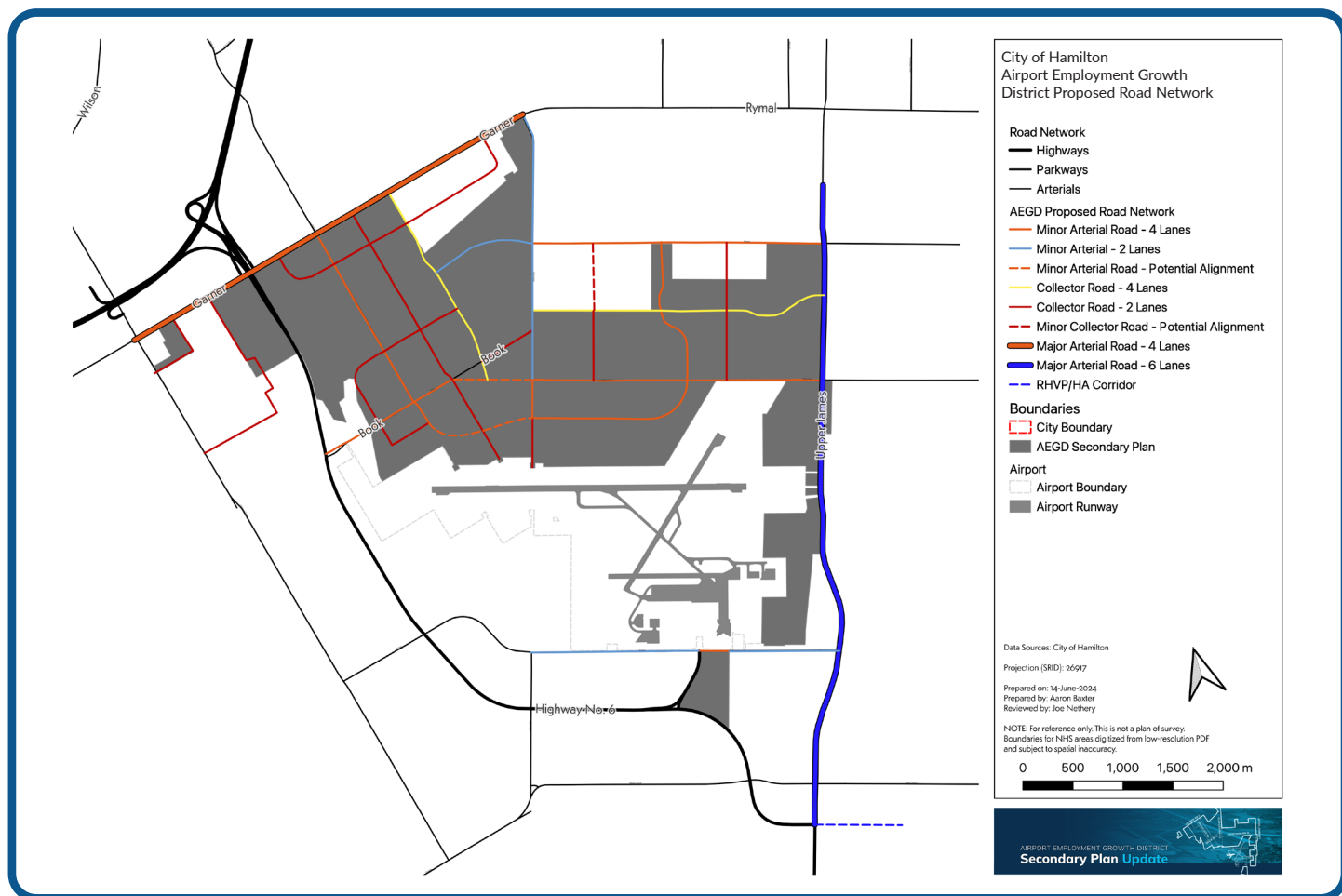
Airport Employment Growth District Secondary Plan Update

In November 2023, Council approved an update to the Transportation Master Plan for the Airport Employment Growth District. This new plan reflects current best practices and standards for the transportation network. To ensure that land use decisions for the Secondary Plan area are consistent with the approved Transportation Master Plan, the Secondary Plan must be updated.

A review of the Natural Heritage System mapping within the Secondary Plan area is also underway, to ensure that the mapping reflects other approved studies. This review includes a refinement of the Natural Heritage System (minor additions and removals) based upon approved Environmental Impact Statements.

A Draft Official Plan Amendment will implement the proposed changes and is required to be approved by Council.

What needs to be updated in the Secondary Plan?

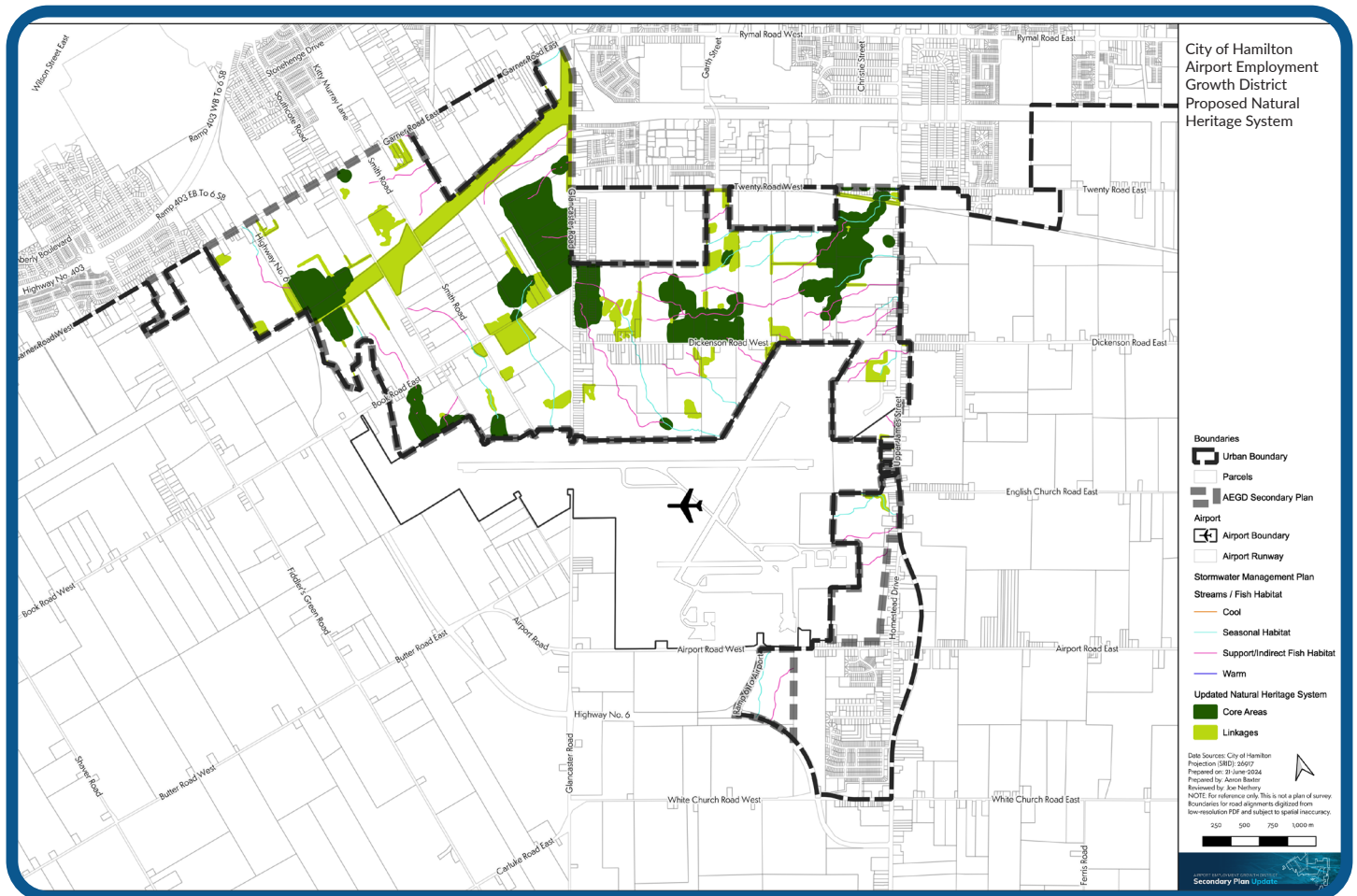
- Updated mapping to show the new multi-modal transportation network
- Updated Transit Network mapping
- Protection for future Priority Transit Use within City policies
- Updates to road width classifications and Right-of-Ways
- Functional Classification, Capacity, and Alignment changes

What's next?

The process of updating the Secondary Plan has four phases. The City of Hamilton is currently in Phase Two, which will be followed by:

- July 2024: Consultation with Indigenous Nations
- Summer 2024: Draft the detailed Official Plan Amendment
- Fall 2024: Statutory public meeting at Planning Committee and final recommendation report
