Staff

Your children are in good hands with Kidaca staff. Each of our camps is under the direction of a full-time staff who has a passion for developing and implementing recreation programs for children and youth. In addition, each group of children will have a dedicated Counsellor who:

- is a university, college, or high school student
- is certified in standard first aid with CPR-level C and is trained to administer Epi-Pens
- has been trained in the HIGH FIVE® Principles of Healthy Child Development
- has specialized training in programming, emergency procedures, group dynamics, and positive behaviour management

Our leaders are energetic and dedicated to providing participants with a fun, safe, and memorable experience this summer!

Behavioural expectations

All children and youth attending recreation programs are expected to behave in a manner which ensures their own safety and the safety of other participants, staff, and volunteers in the program. Staff will be responsible to communicate behavioural expectations, encourage appropriate behaviours and to use group management techniques to create an environment which prevents behaviours from happening.

When responding to behaviours, staff will follow steps in the Behaviour Management Protocol. Parents/Guardians are required to sign off that they understand the Behaviour Management Protocol, and will comply with expectations set for children and youth in programs.



Trips

Camp Kidaca (6-12yrs) include a weekly trip in their fee. Trips will be planned based on their proximity to Hamilton, level of accessibility and the ability to accommodate large camp groups.

Program Overview

Monday - Friday | Hours: 8:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m.

Camp Kidaca 4 - 5 Years

FEE: \$163.50* / week

Our most popular day camp program geared to 4 and 5 year olds. This program is designed to introduce campers to a full-day camp experience. Preschool campers will participate in age appropriate activities, with a focus on outdoor play, building friendships, gross motor skill development, circle time, stories, crafts and outdoor water play. Participants must be able to use the washroom independently and be at least 4 years old at start date of program.

Camp Kidaca 6 - 12 Years

FEE: \$205.05* / week (includes camper t-shirt fee)

Our most popular day camp program! Campers will participate in a variety of age appropriate activities, including swimming, active and cooperative games, crafts, creative time and camp challenges. Camp Kidaca includes a trip by school bus to a local destination. Fee includes t-shirt for camper to wear on trip.

Camp Kidaca 12 - 15 Years

FEE: \$234.60* / week

City of Hamilton is excited to offer an enhanced youth camp- with themes and guests every week! Each day will include themed activities, projects and adventures; plus swimming, physical games, art, leadership activities, video games, chill time and more.



Support Program 4 - 15 Years

(up to 2 weeks) *

The Support Program is available for campers living with disabilities or those who require additional support in order to integrate and participate in Camp Kidaca and Youth programs. Inclusion Counsellors encourage participation, while maintaining safety and care in a fun and stimulating environment! The 2 week limit only applies to City-provided inclusion counsellors. Campers can sign up for unlimited weeks with their own support worker. Public Health requirements will be in place depending on regulations at the start of the program. Participants will be informed via email of any requirements prior to the program start.

Teen Connections 13 - 21 Years

FEE: \$199.05 / week* (up to 2 weeks) **

Teen Connections is a summer recreation and socialization program for participants living with disabilities or those who require additional supports or reduced ratios in order to integrate and participate. Ratios range from 1:1 to 1:3. This camp will be delivered by dedicated program staff who supervise weekly activities and assist with age-appropriate games, walking trips, sports, hobbies, social activities and swimming. Ratios range from 1:1 to 1:3.

Please note: There is no longer a Tween Connections program for Summer. We have openend up to ages 13-21yrs of age in our Teen Connections programs. There will be one program at Westmount Recreation Centre and one program at Bernie Morelli Recreation Centre.

Online Registration

BEFORE REGISTRATION DATE:

Wait List

You have the option of adding a participant to a waitlist for any program that is full at the time of registration. When a space becomes available, waitlisted customers will be contacted via email and have 24 hours to confirm enrollment and provide payment. After 24 hours has lapsed, the offer is cancelled, and we will continue down the waitlist. Ensure your email is current and added to all family members accounts.

Refund Policy

A refund will be issued if notification is received 14 days prior to the beginning of the program. After that time and up to the start of program there will be a withdrawal fee charged. After the program has started programs become nonrefundable.

Camp Subsidy Options

We believe that all residents of Hamilton should have an opportunity to experience the physical, social and emotional benefits that are provided by recreation activities, regardless of financial situation. The following subsidy options are available for Camp Kidaca!

Recreation Assistance Program

You MUST be a current Recreation Assistance Client at the time of registration to be eligible for a discount. The program is open to families living below the Low-Income Measure (LIM).

Visit <u>hamilton.ca/RAP</u> for more information on: How to apply, LIM levels, acceptable documentation and to download the application form.

Forms should be sent to the Recreation Assistance Program office **before February 6, 2025** in order to allow time for processing. Forms submitted later will still be processed, but funds may not be available before the Summer Camp registration date.

Assistance available for approved families;

- You may register your children for up to 15 days (per year), with up to 65% discount
- You may register your children for additional weeks at full price and use your **RAP program** funds to pay a portion of the cost (subject to a 10% co-pay)

Support & Adapted

The Support Program is available for campers who require additional support in order to integrate and participate in Camp Kidaca programs. Summer Inclusion Facilitators encourage participation, while maintaining safety and care in a fun and stimulating environment!

Camp Kidaca Support Program Options:

- 1. City supplied Inclusion Facilitators are available and provided at no additional cost for families! Registration process detailed below. Due to high demand; registration is limited to a maximum of two weeks per participant.
- 2. You may provide your own support person.

Camp Kidaca welcomes support persons who assist participants living with a disability or those that require assistance to participate in recreational programs. Support persons are hired or chosen by the participant to provide assistance throughout the camp day. **The support person is responsible to ensure the participant follows behavioural guidelines.** There are no fees charged for support persons (registration in the Camp Kidaca program is required).

Once you have completed all the above steps the inclusion team will process your registration.

Caregivers can request daily program hours of 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., or 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
