Description of the corrective measures required and/or implemented:			<ul> <li>On February 20, 2025, the following corrective measures were required:</li> <li>Dental appointments were cancelled,</li> <li>Clinic was instructed to reprocess all reusable equipment and ensure sterilization follows best practices, including proper cleaning, use of Class 5 chemical indicators and biological indicators, and record keeping.</li> <li>Ensure sterilization pouches are appropriately labelled,</li> </ul>		

Date and list of any Order(s) or Directive(s) that were issued to the owner/operator (if applicable):	<ul> <li>Ensure efficacy logs for ultrasonic cleaner are appropriately maintained as per PIDAC best practices,</li> <li>Ensure one-way workflow from dirty to clean in the reprocessing area,</li> <li>Provide alcohol-based hand rub at the reprocessing sink and dedicate the sink for reprocessing only,</li> <li>Staff to complete Public Health Ontario modules – Reprocessing in the Community,</li> <li>Ensure gowns for personal protective equipment are on site,</li> <li>Ensure current SDS are on site for cleaning and disinfecting products.</li> <li>Verbal Section 13 Order given February 20, 2025</li> <li>Written Section 13 Order given February 21, 2025</li> </ul>
