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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Soil Engineers Ltd. was retained by Cedar City Developments to carry out a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (hereinafter referred to as "Phase I ESA") in accordance with Canadian Standards Association (CSA) Standard Z768-01 (reaffirmed in 2022) for a property located at 7505 Airport Road East, in the City of Hamilton (hereinafter referred to as "the subject site").

The purpose of the study was to identify any potential environmental concerns associated with the subject site. The findings from our research of documents pertaining to the subject site, interviews with persons knowledgeable of the subject site and an environmental site reconnaissance, together with our assessment, are presented in this report.

The subject site is comprised of a farmland with three (3) barns in the north-western and north-eastern portions of the subject site. The neighbouring properties consist of agricultural and residential properties to the north, east and west, and agricultural properties to the south of the subject site.

The Phase I ESA has revealed the following items of environmental concerns attendant to the subject site:

- Potential use of pesticides during agricultural activities including a historical orchard located in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- One (1) fuel oil above-ground storage tank (AST) is located to the west of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site.
- Two (2) abandoned fuel ASTs are located to the south of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site.
- One (1) waste oil AST is located inside the northern barn at the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- Four (4) fuel oil ASTs are located to the southwest of the north-eastern barns in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- Operation and Maintenance Yard associated with waste generator including waste



oil and light fuel is located adjacent to the northeast of the subject site.

In accordance with Canadian Standards Association (CSA) Standard Z768-01, a Phase II ESA is required to address the findings of the Phase I ESA

Please note that the information supplied by this report, and its format does not meet all the requirements as set out in the Ontario Regulation (O. Reg.) 153/04, as amended. Therefore, this report cannot be used in support of a filing of a Record of Site Condition (RSC) with the Environmental Site Registry (ESR) of the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP).

If there is intent to file an RSC, a Phase One Environmental Site Assessment in accordance with all the requirements of the O. Reg. 153/04, as amended, must be completed prior to submission of an RSC for filing.



2.0 INTRODUCTION

2.1 General

In accordance with our proposal, dated February 13, 2023, as authorized by Mr. Harrison Demone, P.Eng. of Cedar City Developments, Soil Engineers Ltd. (SEL) has carried out a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (Phase I ESA) for a property located at 7505 Airport Road East, in the City of Hamilton (hereinafter referred to as "the subject site").

The study was conducted in general conformance with the Canadian Standards Association (CSA) Standards Z768-01 (reaffirmed in 2022).

The purpose of this study was to identify any potential environmental concerns associated with the subject site and its neighbouring properties which could affect the environmental conditions at the subject site.

2.2 Scope of Work

This Phase I ESA consists of the following:

- Review of records to assess current and past activities which may have potential impacts on the environmental conditions of the subject site.
- A site reconnaissance inspection for identification of any potential on-site environmental concerns.
- Observation of adjacent properties and their potential impacts on the subject site.
- Interviews with persons knowledgeable of the subject site.
- Preparation of this report containing the findings, relevant research documents and the assessment.



2.3 Site Description

The subject site, as shown on the Site Location Plan, Drawing No. 1, is located at 7505 Airport Road East, in the City of Hamilton. The subject site is comprised of one (1) Property Identification Number (PIN), 17394-0075 (LT) shown on the Property Index Map, Drawing No. 2.

The property information obtained from the Parcel Register, the land transfer documents, and UTM coordinates obtained from Google Earth are given in the table below:

The subject site is irregular in shape, encompassing an approximate area of 93.80 hectare (ha) (231.79 acres (ac)).

3.0 RECORDS REVIEW

3.1 Land Title Search

A land title search was conducted for the subject site at the Wentworth Land Registry Office (ONLAND). A copy of the land ownership history is provided in Appendix 'A'.

The earliest records show that the subject site was part of Lots 9 and 10 in Concession 5, in the Town of Glanford.



A Historical Map drafted in 1875 was located from McGill University, Canadian County Atlas Digital Project database on February 16, 2023. A copy of the map is presented on Drawing No. 3, showing that the subject site was part of the estate owned by W. Young, T. Webber, I. Daffield Sr. and J. Hostein at that time. Based on the size and shape of the estate, the subject site appeared to be used for agricultural purposes including one (1) structure and an orchard located in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.

Throughout the researched years, the land was subdivided, with the ownership of the subject site changing several times between private individuals and companies. The most recent transaction for the subject site is listed in the table below:

3.2 Previous Environmental Reports

SEL is not aware of any previous environmental reports prepared for the subject site.

3.3 Area Mapping

Maps of the subject site were located at Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (OMNRF) on February 13 and 16, 2023. A 2010 Ontario Base Map (OBM) and a 2022 Topographic Map were available for our review, showing the land features at those dates. Copies of the maps are presented on Drawing Nos. 4 and 5, respectively. Based on the 2010 OBM, subject site appeared to be a farmland at that time. At least four (4) structures could be located in the north-eastern and one (1) structure in the north-western portions of the subject site. Based on the topography of the area, general precipitation runoff from the subject site is expected to drain in easterly, north-easterly in the northern portion of the subject site and south-westerly direction in the southern portion of the subject site. The subject site is located adjacent to the roadways (Airport Road East, Miles Road and White Church Road East to the north, east and south, respectively).



3.4 Aerial Photographs

Aerial photographs of the subject site and surrounding areas were found at University of Toronto Map and Data Library, National Air Photo Library and Google Earth on March 9, 2023. A review of the aerial photographs dated 1954, 1965, 1973, 1980 2005, 2009, 2018 and 2022 indicates that the subject site has mainly been used for agricultural purposes. Copies of the aerial photographs are presented in Appendix 'C'. A review of the aerial photographs is summarized in the table below:

It should be noted that in all aerial photographs, the subject site is adjacent the roadways (Airport Road East, Miles Road and White Church Road East to the north, east and south, respectively).

3.5 <u>Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) Records and</u> Databases

MECP Waste Disposal Sites

Active and closed landfill sites located in excess of 1 kilometre (km) from the subject site are considered to have no significant potential for environmental impact at the subject site. On February 14, 2023, SEL reviewed the Ontario MECP "Waste Disposal Site Inventory", dated June 1991. There is no record of any active or closed waste disposal site at the subject site and within 1 km of the subject site.



Industrial Sites Producing or Using Coal Tar and Related Tars in Ontario

On February 14, 2023, SEL reviewed the MECP "Inventory of Industrial Sites Producing or Using Coal Tar and Related Tars in Ontario", dated November 1988, and the "Inventory of Coal Gasification Plant Waste Sites in Ontario", dated April 1987. There is no record of any coal gasification plant, coal tar distillation plant, creosote plant, etc., at or within the vicinity of the subject site and within 1 km from the subject site.

Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCB) Waste Storage Sites

The MECP "Ontario Inventory of PCB Storage Sites", dated October 1991 and April 1995 respectively, were reviewed on February 14, 2023. The subject site is not listed as a PCB waste storage site and no storage site is listed for the properties within 250 m radius from the subject site.

MECP Waste Generator

The MECP Waste Generator Registration database files, dated 2000, 2008, 2015, 2018 and 2020 were reviewed on February 14, 2023. The subject site is not listed as a waste generator under Ontario Regulation (O. Reg.) 347, as amended of the Environmental Protection Act (EPA) and no properties within 250 m radius from the subject site are listed as waste generators.

MECP Freedom of Information (FOI)

A request for documented environmental concerns and citations pertaining to the subject site was forwarded to the MECP Freedom of Information Office on February 14, 2023. Based on their response letter, dated February 21, 2023, no records were located responsive to our request. A Copy of the MECP Freedom of Information Request and Response Letter are presented in Appendix 'C'.



Well Records

The MECP's help desk at Water Well Ontario was contacted on February 13, 2023 regarding the subject site and the surrounding areas. Two (2) well records are located at the subject site and twenty-five (25) well records are located at neighbouring properties within 250 m from the subject site. A copy of the MECP Well Records is presented in Appendix 'D'.

3.6 Other Sources

Fire Insurance Plans (FIP)

A search for fire insurance plan was conducted at Opta Information Intelligence (OPTA) through Environmental Risk Information Services (ERIS) on February 17, 2023. No fire insurance plan is available for the subject site or neighbouring properties within 250 m radius from the subject site. A copy of OPTA Enviroscan report is included in Appendix 'E'.

Environmental Risk Information Service (ERIS) Ltd.

ERIS Ltd. provides reports that compile information from both government and private databases of interest to the environmental field. The ERIS database report for the subject site and the western neighbouring parcel (Report No. 23021000619), dated February 13, 2023, is presented in Appendix 'F'. The database and number of notable records pertaining to the subject site and the neighbouring properties located within 250 m radius from the subject site are listed in the table below:

Ontario Regulation 347 Waste Generators Summary (GEN)

This database records the registered facilities, equipment and operations that are involved in the production, collection, handling or storage of waste from 1986 to October 2022. No records are listed for the subject site and fourteen (14) records were identified for the neighbouring properties within 250 m radius from the subject site boundaries. Ontario Spills (SPL)

Information such as the location (approximate), type and quantity of contaminant, date of spill, environmental impact, cause, nature of impact, etc. are recorded in the database. There is no record for the subject site and one (1) SPL record is listed for a property within 250 m radius from the subject site boundaries. Details are listed in the table below:

3.7 Occupancy Search

ERIS Ltd. provided SEL with an occupancy search report for the subject site and the neighbouring properties within 250 m of the subject site boundaries on February 22, 2023, using the 1998, 2000, 2012, 2017 and 2021 City Directories. The records indicate that the subject site was occupied with sod farms. Residential structures, town facility, Developer Company, dry wall and masonry contractors were located within 250 m radius from the subject site boundaries. Residential structures, Developer Company, dry wall and masonry contractors are not considered to be environmental concerns with respect to the subject site. A copy of the occupancy search report is provided in Appendix 'G'.

3.8 Records Review Summary

A summary of the relevant information disclosed by our records review is given below:

- The subject site has been used for agricultural purposes including an orchard area located in the north-eastern portion of the subject site. (Sources: Historical Map and Aerial Photographs)
- Operation and Maintenance Yard associated with waste generator including waste oil and light fuel is located adjacent to the northeast of the subject site. (Sources: ERIS Report and Occupancy Search)
- A historical diesel fuel spill incident is listed approximately 156 m to the northeast of the subject site. (Sources: ERIS Report)
- Watercourse tributaries are located in the eastern, northern and south-western portions of the subject site. (Sources: Aerial Photographs, Maps and OMNRF)
- Two (2) ponds are located in the central and south-eastern portions of the subject site. (Sources: Aerial Photographs, Maps and OMNRF)



- Two (2) well records are located at the subject site and twenty-five (25) well records at neighbouring properties within 250 m from the subject site. (Sources: OMNRF)
- The subject site is adjacent to the roadways (Airport Road East, Miles Road and White Church Road East to north, east and south, respectively). (Sources: Maps and Aerial Photographs)



4.0 SITE RECONNAISSANCE

4.1 General

A visual inspection of the subject site and the publicly accessible areas of the surrounding properties was conducted by SEL representative, Mr. Ashish Kumar Bishnoi, on February 16, 2023, to determine the general environmental condition of the subject site. The conditions and timing of the site visit are presented in the table below:

Site photographs taken during the inspection are presented in Appendix 'H'.

At the time of site inspection, the subject site was comprised of a farmland with three (3) barns in the north-western and north-eastern portions of the subject site. Watercourses tributaries are located in the eastern, northern and south-western portions of the subject site. The neighbouring properties consist of agricultural and residential properties to the north, east and west, and agricultural properties to the south of the subject site. City of Hamilton Operation and Maintenance Yard is located adjacent to the northeast of the subject site.

The ground surface is relatively flat with minor undulations, and the grade at the subject site descends towards northeast, east and southwest. There was no visible sign of any underground storage tank or area where fill material was placed or graded on the subject site. Two (2) ponds are located in the central and south-eastern portions of the subject site. Excavated soil material from the pond was stockpiled in the vicinity of the central pond at the subject site. The subject site is adjacent to the roadways (Airport Road East, Miles Road and White Church Road East to north, east and south, respectively).



4.2 Specific Observations at Subject Site

(i) **Building Inspection**

At the time of site inspection, three (3) barns are located in the north-western and north-eastern portions of the subject site.

Barn in North-western Portion

At the time of the site reconnaissance, one (1) barn is located in the north-western portion of the subject site. Exterior of the barn is constructed with the metal sheets, concrete flooring and metal roofing atop. The barn is heated with the oil furnace. The oil furnace is located in the southwest corner of the barn at the subject site. Mowing equipment and jerry cans were observed in the barn located at the subject site. One fuel oil AST is located to the west of barn at the subject site. Two (2) abandoned ASTs are located to the south of the barn at the subject site.

Barns in North-eastern Portion

At the time of site reconnaissance, two (2) barns are located in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.

Exterior of the northern barn is constructed with the metal sheets, concrete flooring and metal roofing atop. Farming vehicles and equipment are parked inside the barn at the subject site. One (1) waste oil AST is located inside the northern barn at the subject site. Lubricant and motor oil containers were observed in the barn at the subject site. The barn is serviced with municipal hydro and natural gas service. One (1) water well and septic system are located to the east of the barn in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.

Exterior of the eastern barn is constructed with wooden framing, concrete flooring and metal roofing atop. Seed for sod production farming, tires and jerry cans were stored



inside the barn at the subject site. Four (4) oil ASTs are located to the southwest of the barns in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.

(ii) Hazardous Materials

Asbestos-Containing Materials (ACMs)

ACMs were widely used in building construction until the mid- to late 1970s, primarily for the good insulation and fire retardant properties of asbestos. The health risks associated with asbestos occur when asbestos fibers are released from various materials into the ambient air.

Based on the age of the barns, it is possible that ACMs may have been used in the building construction.

Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs)

PCBs commonly exist in electrical equipment such as transformers, capacitors, and in the ballasts of fluorescent and high-intensity discharge (HID) light fixtures. The use of PCBs in newly manufactured electrical equipment was discontinued in 1979.

Based on the age of the barns, it is possible that PCBs are present in the electrical equipment present at the subject site.

<u>Urea-Formaldehyde Foam Insulation (UFFI)</u>

UFFI was commonly used in the mid-1970s for insulation in buildings and was discontinued in 1980.

Based on the age of the barns, it is possible that UFFI may have been used in the building components.

Ozone-Depleting Substances (ODSs)

Sources of ODSs found in the form of chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) are used in airconditioning units and refrigeration systems.

Based on our inspection, sources of ODSs were not observed at the subject site.

Lead

Lead was commonly used in old plumbing pipes and solder, in the manufacturing of paint as a drying agent and for pigmentation. The use of lead has been reduced, and was phased out of use, in plumbing solder during the 1980s and from pipes during the 1990s. The use of lead in the manufacturing of new paint was phased out during the 1970s for interior house paint and during the late 1990s for exterior paint.

Based on the age of the structures, it is possible that lead-based materials may be present on the painted surfaces of the structures at the subject site. Although the pipes are suspected to be made of copper, it is possible that lead-based solder may have been used. No deteriorating painted surface was observed.

<u>Mercury</u>

Mercury is generally a component of thermometers, thermostats and fluorescent lighting tubes. Our visual inspection of the subject site indicated that these items were in use. Provided that these items are left intact, they remain safe in their present form.

<u>Silica</u>

Silica is a natural material found in rocks and masonry units. Our visual inspection indicated that these materials were used in the construction of the building. As long as these materials remain intact, they are safe in their present form.



(iii) Underground Storage Tanks (UST)

At the time of site reconnaissance, there is no evidence to indicate the presence of any UST at the subject site.

(iv) Above-Ground Storage Tank (AST)

At the time of the inspection, the following ASTs are located at the subject site:

- One (1) fuel oil AST is located to the west of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site.
- Two (2) abandoned fuel ASTs are located to the south of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site.
- One (1) waste oil AST is located inside the northern barn at the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- Four (4) fuel oil ASTs are located to the southwest of the north-eastern barns in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.

(v) Substance Containers

Our representatives checked for the presence of substance containers such as oil drums, used oil containers, gasoline jerry cans, paint cans, etc.

At the time of the site reconnaissance, gasoline jerry cans were observed in the barns at the subject site. The containers were found to be stored properly and no concerns were observed.

(vi) Waste Management and Maintenance Practices

No waste is generated at the subject site.



(vii) Air Quality and Noise

At the time of the site reconnaissance, there was no offensive odour or detectable source of air emissions that may impact the ambient air quality at the subject site. No unexpected noise level greater than the ambient noise was noted at the subject site. Ambient noise includes the noise of traffic along Airport Road East, Miles Road and White Church Road East to north, east and south, respectively.

(viii) Water Wells and Septic System

One (1) water well and a septic system are located at the subject site. The approximate UTM Coordinates of the water well and septic system are as follows:

(ix) Neighbouring Properties Inspection

Based on our visual inspection of the publicly accessible areas, the neighbouring properties consist of agricultural and residential properties to the north, east and west, and agricultural properties to the south of the subject site. City of Hamilton Operation and Maintenance Yard is located adjacent to the northeast of the subject site.

(x) Enhanced Property Investigation

There is no industrial processing, dry cleaning service with chemical use, chemical manufacturing or handling carried out at the subject site in the past or at the time of this Phase One ESA site reconnaissance. Therefore, no enhanced property investigation was conducted.



4.3 Summary of Site Reconnaissance

Our site reconnaissance, conducted on February 16, 2023 has revealed the following items which warrant further discussion:

- The subject site has been used for agricultural purposes.
- One (1) fuel oil AST is located to the west of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site.
- Two (2) abandoned fuel ASTs are located to the south of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site.
- One (1) waste oil AST is located in the northern barn at the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- Four (4) fuel oil ASTs are located to the southwest of the north-eastern barns in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- One (1) water well and septic system are located to the east of the barn in the northeastern portion of the subject site.
- Excavated soil material from the pond was stockpiled in the vicinity of the central pond at the subject site.
- Two (2) ponds are located in the central and south-eastern portions of the subject site.
- Watercourses tributaries are located in the eastern, northern and south-western portions of the subject site.
- City of Hamilton Operation and Maintenance Yard is located adjacent to the northeast of the subject site.
- The neighbouring properties consist of agricultural and residential properties to the north, east and west, and agricultural properties to the south of the subject site.
- The subject site is adjacent to the roadways (Airport Road East, Miles Road and White Church Road East to north, east and south, respectively).



5.0 INTERVIEWS

5.1 Owner Interview

Mr. Trevor Vanderwoude, the contact person for the subject site, was interviewed on February 16, 2023. Based on his understanding, the subject site has been actively used for agricultural purposes. Fuel ASTs are located at the subject site. Water well and septic systems are located at the subject site. He has no knowledge of any records of USTs, dumping, storage, stain, odour, and spill at the subject site. A copy of the interview document is included in Appendix 'I'.

During the site reconnaissance, he indicated that the excavated soil material from the pond was stockpiled in the vicinity of the central pond at the subject site.

5.2 **Summary of Interview**

- The subject site has been actively used for agricultural purposes.
- Fuel ASTs are located at the subject site.
- Excavated soil material from the pond was stockpiled in the vicinity of the pond at the subject site.
- Water well and septic systems are located at the subject site.



6.0 FINDINGS AND EVALUATION OF FINDINGS

Soil Engineers Ltd. was retained by of Cedar City Developments to carry out a Phase I ESA for a property located at 7505 Airport Road East, in the City of Hamilton (the 'subject site'). The subject site is comprised of farmland with three (3) barns in the north-western and north-eastern portions of the subject site. The neighbouring properties consist of agricultural and residential properties to the north, east and west, and agricultural properties to the south of the subject site.

Based on the information obtained through our record review, the visual observations recorded during our site reconnaissance and interviews, the Phase I ESA has revealed the following items that require further consideration:

- The majority of subject site has been used for agricultural purposes including a
 historical orchard located in the north-eastern portion of the subject site. (Sources:
 Records Review, Interview and Site Reconnaissance)
- One (1) fuel oil AST is located to the west of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site. (Sources: Site Reconnaissance)
- Two (2) abandoned fuel ASTs are located to the south of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site. (Sources: Site Reconnaissance)
- One (1) waste oil AST is located inside the northern barn at the north-eastern portion of the subject site. (Sources: Site Reconnaissance)
- Four (4) fuel oil ASTs are located to the southwest of the north-eastern barns in the north-eastern portion of the subject site. (Sources: Site Reconnaissance)
- Operation and Maintenance Yard associated with waste generator including waste oil and light fuel is located adjacent to the northeast of the subject site. (Sources: Records Review and Site Reconnaissance)
- A historical diesel Fuel spill incident is listed approximately 156 m to the northeast of the subject site. (Sources: Records Review)
- Excavated soil material from the pond was stockpiled in the vicinity of the central pond at the subject site. (Sources: Interview and Site Reconnaissance)
- Watercourse tributaries are located in the eastern, northern and south-western portions
 of the subject site. (Sources: Records Review and Site Reconnaissance)



- Two (2) ponds are located in the central and south-eastern portions of the subject site. (Sources: Records Review and Site Reconnaissance)
- Two (2) well records and septic system are located at the subject site and twenty-five (25) well records at neighbouring properties within 250 m from the subject site. (Sources: Records Review and Site Reconnaissance)
- The subject site is adjacent to the roadways (Airport Road East, Miles Road and White Church Road East to north, east and south, respectively).). (Sources: Records Review and Site Reconnaissance)

Evaluations of each of these items and their effects on the subject site are given below:

Pesticide Use

Based on our records review, interview and site reconnaissance, the subject site has been used for agricultural purposes including a historical orchard located in the north-eastern portion of the subject site. There is potential contamination from pesticides at the subject site from their long-term use on the fields. This is considered to possess a high potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site.

Fuel ASTs at the subject site

Based on site inspection, following ASTs are located at the subject site:

- One (1) fuel oil AST is located to the west of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site. The fuel oil AST is considered to possess a high potential to influence the environmental quality of the subject site.
- Two (2) abandoned fuel ASTs are located to the south of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site. The fuel ASTs are considered to possess a high potential to influence the environmental quality of the subject site.
- One (1) waste oil AST is located inside the northern barn at the north-eastern portion of the subject site. The waste oil AST is considered to possess a high potential to influence the environmental quality of the subject site.
- Four (4) fuel oil ASTs are located to the southwest of the north-eastern barns in the



north-eastern portion of the subject site. The fuel oil ASTs are considered to possess a high potential to influence the environmental quality of the subject site.

Operation and Maintenance Yard at the neighbouring Property

Based on our records review and site reconnaissance, an Operation and Maintenance yard (i.e., City of Hamilton) associated with waste generator including waste oil and light fuel is located at 7098 Airport Road East, adjacent to the northeast of the subject site. Considering the nature of the activities and close proximity between this property and the subject site, this item is considered to possess a high potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site.

Stockpiled Soil at the Subject Site

Based on interview and site reconnaissance, excavated soil material from the pond was stockpiled in the vicinity of the central pond at the subject site. Excavated soil material from the pond stockpiled at the subject is not considered to be environmental concerns with respect to the subject site.

Spill within 250 m radius from the Subject Site Boundaries

Based on our records review, a historical diesel fuel spill incident occurred at Miles Road and Airport Road, approximately 156 m to the northeast and presumed down-gradient of the subject site. Considering relatively significant distance between this property and the subject site, this item is considered to possess a low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site.

Other Environmental Items:

Adjacent Roadways

The subject site is adjacent to roadways (Airport Road East, Miles Road and White Church



Road East to north, east and south, respectively). This is of concern due to the de-icing chemicals used during the winter season which may result in higher than usual levels for the Sodium Adsorption Ratio and Electrical Conductivity of the soil. If the soil remains in situ, it is considered to meet the standards through clause 49.1 of O. Reg. 153/04.

Water Bodies and Areas of Natural Significance

Based on the records review, watercourse tributaries are located in the eastern, northern and south-western portions of the subject site. Two (2) ponds are located in the central and south-eastern portions of the subject site.

Water Wells and Septic Systems

Based on the records review and reconnaissance, two (2) well records and septic system are located at the subject site and twenty-five (25) well records at neighbouring properties within 250 m from the subject site boundaries.

Designated Substances

Based on our research and the age of the on-site structures and septic system, designated substances may be present in a form that is not visible to the eye. This possibility should be brought to the attention of any workers that perform work or occupants that inhabit that area.

It should be noted that suspected hazardous materials were identified or may be contained within the on-site structures. Since it is unlikely the structures are to be part of the new development, the designated substances will be dealt with prior to any demolition of the structures as part of the Occupational Health and Safety Act. The designated substances are not a part of this environmental assessment.



7.0 CONCLUSIONS

Based on the information obtained through our review of records, interview and visual observations recorded during our site reconnaissance, the Phase I ESA has revealed the following items of environmental concerns attendant to the subject site:

- Potential use of pesticides during agricultural activities including a historical orchard area located in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- One (1) fuel oil AST is located to the west of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site.
- Two (2) abandoned fuel ASTs are located to the south of barn in the north-western portion of the subject site.
- One (1) waste oil AST is located inside the northern barn at the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- Four (4) fuel oil ASTs are located to the southwest of the north-eastern barns in the north-eastern portion of the subject site.
- Operation and Maintenance Yard associated with waste generator including waste
 oil and light fuel is located adjacent to the northeast of the subject site.

In accordance with Canadian Standards Association (CSA) Standard Z768-01, a Phase II ESA is required to address the findings of the Phase I ESA


