

STORMWATER FEE FORM FOR NEW DEVELOPMENT

Purpose of this Form

This form is to be used exclusively for new developments in conjunction with the site plan application (if required) for multi-residential properties (seven or more units) and/or Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional (ICI) properties.

General

The City of Hamilton collects information under authority of Section 227 of the Municipal Act, 2001. Any personal information collected for Stormwater Incentive Program will be used to ensure eligibility for the Stormwater Incentive Program Rebates. By providing your email address, you are consenting to receiving emails from the City of Hamilton and/or their agents/contractors to verify the details of the incentive and ensure the garden or measure is in operational condition and effective. Information collected for this initiative may be stored on servers located in Canada and the United States and may be subject to Canadian and/or American laws. Consumers whose premise is not in compliance with any of the provisions of the Sewer Use By-law, No. 14-090, as amended, are not eligible for the Stormwater Rate Incentive Program, along with consumers who are not in good financial standing with the City of Hamilton.

The General Manager or an Officer may enter on land at any reasonable time and in accordance with the conditions set out in sections 435 and 437 of the Municipal Act, 2001, to carry out an inspection.
